For a few years at the seminary I was asked to write what was called a self- assessment that meant to speak about oneself so that we could be evaluated by the seminary's faculty. That was never an easy thing to do. I have always found hard to speak about myself. However, this time I would say a few words about me so you could start knowing me a little bit more. I was born in central Mexico, in the state of Jalisco. I come from what is considered now a big family: my parents, five sisters, two brothers and myself. I grew up in a deeply Catholic family. When I was nineteen I joined the religious order of the Augustinian Recollects. I was a member of that religious community for about ten years until I came to the Diocese of Santa Rosa. My first assignment in the Diocese of Santa Rosa was at St. Joseph's Church in Fortuna. I was then a seminarian. I worked there doing pastoral work within the Spanish speaking faithful. I was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Santa Rosa on July 6, 2002. After ordination I was assigned to serve at Saint Mary of the Angles Church in Ukiah. I Served the Catholic community of Ukiah for five years and then assigned to Saint Vincent de Paul Church in Petaluma. I served at St, Vincent's Parish for less than two yeas when I was called to come and serve all of you here at Sacred Heart. It has been an honor and a blessing for me to be a Roman Catholic Priest. I was ordained to served in the Catholic Church, which is universal. I have to say that I am happy to be here. It is an honor for me to be a part of this community and I am looking forward to meet each and every one of you. May the Lord bless all of you and keep you in his Peace.
