A Message from Bishop Walsh

My Dear People,

With the continuing threat of Swine flu (H1N1) in our area, several doctors have requested I put into effect the restrictions that were in place earlier this year.

Therefore, I suggest that until future notice we refrain from holding hands at the Our Father, shaking of hand for the sign of peace and receiving the Lord in communion from the Precious Blood in the chalice.

Other precautions such as washing hands prior to distributing Holy Communion should also be observed.

I know that these restrictions limit each one of us in our liturgies but they are for the common health and good of all. From what the doctors say, these guidelines make common sense at the time.

I thank you for cooperating in this matter and I wish you all good health in the days ahead.

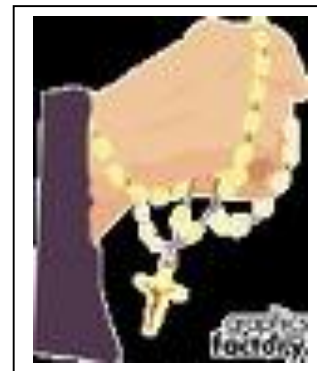
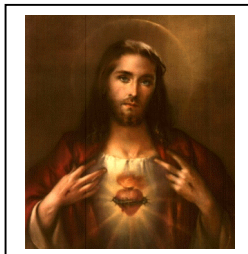
